

## **The School of Management Undergraduate Poster Competition 2019 Registration Packet**

### **What is the Undergraduate Poster Competition?**

The School of Management Undergraduate Poster Competition 2019 is the 7th annual School of Management (SOM) poster competition. Participants are invited to create a 36" x 41" poster to reflect any research or experiential learning that they have been involved. The competitors will display and present their work to a panel of faculty judges. The panel of judges will evaluate the projects and award an assortment of cash prizes. Current students attending the competition will be invited to vote for a special "**People's Choice**," distinction that will carry a \$500 prize.

### **Applied Experience Category**

The Applied Experience category consists of projects based on work/internship experience or on other out-of-classroom activities. The overall idea is to showcase learning experiences, developmental activities, social and charitable projects, or other ways in which you have applied your skills. The poster should show what you accomplished or learned.

### **Research Category**

This category is for research projects and may include projects developed in class, or as part of assistantships. This category is also very open ended, and the overall objective is to showcase your research design and findings.

### **Social Innovation Category**

This category is for projects developed and deployed effective solutions to challenging and often systemic social and environmental issues in support of social progress. This may be an ongoing project, but can showcase the work you have accomplished thus far.

### **Global Experience Category**

This category is for posters based on a student's global abroad experience or projects/research that have a global based theme. This may be an on going project, but it should display how the project has a global affect.

### **CURCA**

Posters presented in the Undergraduate Poster Competition are eligible to be showcased in the University-wide Celebration of Academic Excellence on April 25<sup>th</sup> 2019. If you are interested in displaying your poster, please indicate your interest on the application.

### **What can students win?**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Place: Applied Experience - \$750
- 1<sup>st</sup> Place: Research Poster - \$750
- 1<sup>st</sup> Place Social Innovation Poster - \$750
- 1<sup>st</sup> Place Global Experience Poster - \$750
- Open House Choice - \$500
