



## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Academic performance in the freshman and sophomore classes is the main criterion for admission to the upper division of the School of Management. In the first two years, students complete the university writing requirements, general education courses, and **seven prerequisite** courses. To be admitted to the School of Management and be permitted to take upper-level (300 or 400 level) School of Management courses, the following requirements must be satisfied:

- **Completion of the seven prerequisite courses with a *minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5*.** If a course is repeated, the second grade is computed into the prerequisite GPA. (*Students may not take a course for a third time.*)
- Minimum overall and UB GPA of 2.0 to be considered in good academic standing with the university.
- Completion of a minimum of 50 credit hours.
- Students applying to Accounting or Internal Auditing will also need a minimum of B in MGA 201 and MGA 202 to be considered.

Students entering in the spring semester should be aware of possible course sequence problems that may necessitate registering in summer school or waiting additional semesters to take specific courses.

## WHAT ARE THE SEVEN PREREQUISITES?

- Macroeconomics (ECO 181)
- Microeconomics (ECO 182)
- Introductory Psychology (PSY 101)
- Mathematical Analysis for Business (MTH 131) or a two-semester calculus sequence
- Introduction to Computers and Statistics for Management (MGQ 201)
- Introduction to Accounting I (MGA 201)
- Introduction to Accounting II (MGA 202)

## WHO SHOULD APPLY AND WHEN?

Current UB students not yet admitted to the School of Management may apply for admission according to the following application deadlines:

- **Spring Admission:** October 1
- **Fall Admission:** March 1 and June 15

You should apply during the semester in which you are enrolled in your final prerequisite courses.
